Pale gold in colour, De Castellane's Brut 'Croix Rouge' exhibits fine and generous bubbles. The bouquet, which contains fragrances of white flowers, fresh fruit compote and brioche, gives the wine elegance and finesse. On the palate, the aromas evoke hints of vanilla, white-fleshed fruits and gingerbread.

The Brut Rosé has a delicate salmon pink colour. The fruity and floral nose has delicate aromas of gooseberry and strawberry. The palate has a complexity with roundness and freshness combining the delightful flavours of stewed and wild strawberries.

A straw gold colour and very fine bubbles. Its delicate hue comes from the use of a high percentage of Chardonnay and of the first pressing only. The first aromas reveal the citrus character of the Chardonnay: lime, grapefruits. Then red fruit aromas come out: redcurrant, raspberry, morello cherry –typical Pinot Noir. The palate is full, quite long, with a very clean finish. Elegance -but not without complexity- this wine perfectly illustrates what I call "the house style".

A deep green colour with very fine bubbles and a harmonious combination of citrus and white peach aromas. Lively ample and silky with a creamy effervescence the mouth reveals aromas of toasted bread and grilled almonds. The elegant finish witnesses for the richness of this 95 vintage elaborated with grapes coming from the 4 grand crus. This classy champagne really defines balance and completeness.

13	2006 Mourvèdre, Spice Route, South Africa  Warm, jammy nose with a touch of spice and vanilla leads to a juicy palate with red fruit, mocha and characteristic, refreshing acidity.	26.00	6.50

This 7 hectare vineyard is planted with 80% Merlot and 20% of Cabernet Franc. The wines produced are typical Lussac-St-Emilion, after 18 months in the barrel these wines are a beautiful garnet-red colour, very ripe fruit based nose and great balance, rounded tannins which ensures long ageing.

19      2007 Hautes Côtes de Nuits, Bouchard Père et fils, Burgundy, France      42.00

A ripe, supple and pure style, with black cherry and blackberry accented by light oak spice. Modern in style, with fine harmony and balance, it finishes long.

20      2007 Morgon Marcel Lapierre, Beaujolais, France      46.00

From biodynamic producer Marcel Lapierre, this is probably as good as it got in 2007. It's a light and elegant wine, concentrated, although the crisp fruits of the year tend to dominate. There are raspberry flavors, very pure, very fresh, but with some good depth of flavor.

206      2001 Antiquus Shiraz Old Vines, Peter Lehmann, Barossa Valley, Australia      48.00

Deep coloured. Ripe nose is lovely with complex black fruits, herbs and some olive character. Some smokiness too. Rich, concentrated palate is very lush but balanced. This is compelling with lots of rich, spicy fruit. New world style but with some old world finesse. Very good/excellent
